#### Treasurer's Report

Taxes were filed electronically today, Alicia needs to sign tax forms, she was president last year. Since we didn't generate much revenue, our report was not as comprehensive.

## Committee Updates

### - *Arts*

- Music program - going ahead, it should start in October. They will have to do the program virtually, since partners are not allowed in the building. It will most likely be on Wednesdays, depending on the age of K1-1st. 30min. The teacher is Melissa Tolley, she has joined staff to get to know the teacher. She's fully bi-lingual, has worked with children before.

### - *STEM*

- In Ms. Gaines and Ms. Morales' court to talk with Wentworth directly, Mary will follow up with the teachers.

### - *Playground*

- Last meeting in June, Wentworth was supposed to to come back with some ideas.

### - *Infrastructure*

- Serving line is done, new kitchen is done at the school, still no sink in the library, they did not do ceiling tiles yet, but that is on the list. They did confirm that they will be coming to the school on 11/30 to start the bathroom project, plans are in the works, fixtures have been ordered. Should be done over the weekends.

- There are 9 bathrooms, and they are doing some work on all of them. New stalls, making sure they all have doors, new doors on the exterior to the hallway. Some upgraded ventilation.

- They changed all the batteries in all autoflush toilets, and all of the sinks.

## Events / Fundraising

- Since we will not have our bowling event, it would be good to have an online community event.
- Monica, Alicia, James, Milica will meet and brainstorm ideas.
- Ms. Verano asked about funding for SmartPass, hallway management app, \$2 a student with \$200 set up fee, it's her way of managing how many people are in the hallways/bathrooms. BPS is requiring the school to monitor how many people are in the bathroom.
