## **Annual Appeal Update**

We have made around \$16,000, plus around \$5000 from checks and other sources. Overall, good effort. This is roughly on par with previous years. Jane has been emailing acknowledgement letters - no negative feedback, and we will move forward with email in the future.

### **Committee Updates:**

- Events / Fundraising (Alice's Table success. Ideas for other fundraisers?)

Alice's table was very successful. Great event.

Tricia had an event with Boston Harbor Distillery - we will look into it and plan.

We will look into different options - Escape the room, and similar and see how these events can be leveraged for fundraising.

### - Infrastructure

Bathroom updates are in progress; school should be getting filters but we don't know the timeline.

The goal is to have a purifier in every classroom, and we will supplement anything that BPS will provide.

Many teachers asked for special equipment through DonorsChoose - we will ask the Principal of the needs in the next meeting with her.

#### - Arts

Emily Pierce had a meeting with Karen Gonzales and Community Music Center of Boston (CMCB), to discuss what we can do with the older grades. Discussed song writing class for the older grades. Karen had an idea to do it on a Wednesday, since even if we start hybrid Wednesday will be a catch up day.

Karen will discuss two proposals with principal Verano:

- 1. 8 week long Wednesday afternoon class (4th and 5th grade). It would be after school, and students could opt in.
- 2. One week long intensive full class during the school day.

There is a grant (Stars grant) that CMCB can help us apply for. It could cover up to \$5000, and we would cover the rest. We could run this program as a pilot this year. CBMC has this program running in two other schools, and they have two bilingual teachers they could use for this program. The plan would be to come up with a bigger plan for next year.

We are looking at organizing several smaller events, rather than one large event. We also want to plan for more events for the whole family, including the kids, in addition to tastings/chefinars. We could also do a virtual raffle during these events.
